Breeding Of Table Rabbits

The public is aware that owing to the essation of the importation of store cate for fattening, the price of beef has sen high. Also with the approach of ie cooler weather and the subsequent crease in the consumption of pig meat, ne price of pork is bound to rise from s present low level. Poultry are also able to decrease somewhat in number wing to the difficulty in securing imorted feeding stuffs. In this connexion wners of poultry should utilise garden nd kitchen refuse to the utmost and ouseholders not possessing poultry rould do well to give such refuse to eighbours who keep poultry.

Rabbit keeping has long been popular n Malta. In the cooler weather rabits thrive in Malta and consume little mported food. They will fatten on alnost any vegetable matter, weeds and a ittle leafy dry sulla where available. Labbit keepers and members of the ublic who contemplate keeping rabbits o replenish their meat larder will be inerested to know that the Government experimental Farm has recently acquird a small stud of utility Flemish Giants nd stud bucks are now available for ervice, free of charge, at the Rabbitry, lovernment Experimental Farm, Ghamnieri, Marsa.

This breed when crossed with local ype will produce excellent type able rabbits and rabbit keepers are rged to make use of these facilities. Further particulars may be obtained rom the Poultryman — Phone, Valletta
