PRICE OF KEROSENE RUMOUR SCOTCHED

It is notified for general information that the prevalent rumour that the price of kerosene is being increased is entirely without foundation. This rumour has been responsible for considerable dislocation in the distribution of kerosene during the last few days, as people have been buying unnecessarily large quantities, much in excess of their ordinary requirements, with the result that tank-carts have been unable to cover their normal round. Ample stocks of kerosene are available, but the public are urgently requested in their own interest and to avoid much quite unnecessary hardship, to limit themselves to the purchase of their normal requirements so as not to disturb distribution arrangements which have been working so smoothly for many months.
